This quote provides pricing information for the custom technology development services detailed in the below project objective. The quote is valid until 12/08/2022 and may be accepted at any time prior to that date. This contract is a work-for-hire, which means the resulting work or product becomes the sole property of Client upon remittance of the final payment.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

ThinApp will create a Peer-to-peer E-Wallet platform for iOS, Android and Web where users can load, send and receive money free of credit card transaction costs.

ThinApp will create the following features and deliverables:

Design Phase & Storyboarding - \$500 of budget

ThinApp will work with Client to design all screens of the primary iOS App and website.

iOS Mobile App - XX hrs

- Users can search other users by @username (ie. handle), name (first and/or last) and phone number.
- Users can send or request funds via 2 methods: In-Person or In-Network (ie. via Transmit feature)
- Users who receive "Requests" will see "Approve" and "Reject" buttons in their My Transactions screen to approve or reject the Request.
- In-person Requests prompt the User whom the funds are being requested from to click an "Approve" button on their device to pay the request.

- The home screen will be where the primary search, send, request actions are handled.
- There will be an Invite Friends page.
- There will be an Admin feature in the App.
- There will be FAQ Slides in the App (4 screens) showing how the main features work.
- There will be a verify phone and email feature in the app.
- There will be a Load/Re-Load feature in the app powered by ACH.
- The app will allow Users to login and sign up for their own Member Accounts.

We typically perfect iOS first, then simply use it as a reference to make the Android, which makes the Android Development phase much smoother and quicker than the first, initial iOS Development phase.

WEBSITE - XX hrs

- The website will primarily house Admin features like viewing all transactions, viewing Members, viewing Member Accounts (and info), viewing balances, etc.
- The website will also house how-to-videos with easy copy/paste url links that show Users how to do each of the main functions: Sending, Requesting, Receiving, Loading
- The website will also be the main point of Customer and Technical Support with a Contact Form and contact info.
- The website will have Customer Testimonials/Reviews (that the Admin gets to approve before they display).
- The website will essentially be a marketing landing page for promoting the platform with both Download from the App Store buttons on it.
- The website will also have basic sending, requesting and receiving with 2-factor authentication for security.
- The website will be the primary way for users to load money to their accounts via ACH, which will be powered by Stripe and Plaid.
